ISOI CREDENTIALING GUIDELINES DIPLOMATE

July 2021

ELIGIBILITY & FEE

- Applicant should possess ISOI Mastership before applying for Diplomateship and should have attended three ISOI National conference in the last 7 years.
- Application fee is Rs.35,400/- (Rs.30,000/-+18% GST) for Indian Member.
- US\$ 900/- +applicable taxes for Overseas Member.
- Cheques to favor 'ISOI-ACCREDITATION FUND'. For online transfer, click (link)

PRESENTATION TEMPLATE

 ONLY use the PowerPoint template provided on the ISOI site and upload the completed presentation at (link)

 Send completed application form and fee transaction receipt to the ISOI Secretariat.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- Apart from implant therapy, patient treatment must be complete in all aspects of dentistry including oral prophylaxis, teeth restorations, prosthetic fixed restorations (except in cases of implant-supported over-dentures), surgical or orthodontic interventions etc.
- Untreated edentulous areas (without rationale), partial dentures, untreated caries or periodontal conditions, visible calculus & stains etc. are grounds for rejection.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS (I)

 Diplomateship may be earned through fulfillment of 100 cases (100 separate patients) with 1 year clinical & radiographic follow-up.

 A Diplomate of the ISOI should display the highest degree of proficiency and expertise in implant dentistry, well above the level of Mastership.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS (II)

Case presentation shall include;

- (i) OPGs Pre-operative, post-surgical, post-prosthetic restoration and 1-year post-prosthetic (above 4 OPGs are mandatory)
- (ii) Photographs
- (iii) Patients Case history and Summary.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS (III)

- Documentation should cover complex cases including anterior single tooth restorations, multiple teeth, posterior maxillary cases & distal extension restorations. In addition, it must include;
- 1. More than one implant design to rehabilitate patients.
- 2.Ten (10) cases (10 separate patients with one or both arches) of fixed full arch restorations.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS (IV)

- 3. 3 cases each (total 12) of bone manipulation;
- bone splitting (3 patients),
- horizontal bone augmentation with a minimum gain of 3mm (3 patient),
- open (direct) sinus grafting (3 patient) &
- indirect sinus grafting (3 patient).
- Other bone grafting cases must also be shown.
- (Start your presentation with the 10 full arch & 12 bone manipulation cases)

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS (V)

- Proof of any three (3) of the following to his/her credit;
- Implant paper presentations
- Lectures at national or international implant conferences
- Implant literature publications
- Research in implant dentistry or allied fields etc.
 - (Upload proof along with application form)

RESUBMISSION OF RECORDS

 Diplomateship applicants can re-submit their applications after correction (if needed) only once after the initial submission.

After this, if the case is rejected, the fee will be forfeited and the applicant will have to apply afresh after paying the requisite fees.

EXAMINATION

• Examination of Diplomate applicants will be done at a pre-determined date in a suitable venue with projection audio-visual facilities.

 As per circumstances, the examination may also be conducted virtually online using suitable electronic means.

 Results will be intimated to the successful applicants prior to the National Conference.

PERMISSIONS

- It is the applicant's responsibility to obtain all necessary release and no-objection consents from their respective patients before submission of their records.
- The submitted material can be used in part or whole, for educational purpose by the ISOI & no further permission will need to be obtained according to ISOI constitution. Kindly NOTE this before submission.
